

Impact of Interim Grading Policy on UH and College of Business Policies

GPA Required to Change Major to Pre-Business: “S” (Satisfactory) grades count for credit but do not affect the GPA of a 3.0 or better required to change major to Pre-business.

Filing a Business Degree Plan: Students who select a grade of “S” (Satisfactory) on a course that requires a grade of “C” or better to file a degree plan will be allowed to use that grade to file. “S” grades count for credit but do not affect the GPA of a 2.5 or better required to file.

GPA in Major and Cumulative GPA: A grade of “S” (Satisfactory) counts for credit but do not affect the GPA in Major or the UH cumulative GPA.

GPA for Latin Honors: “S” (Satisfactory) graded courses will be permitted to count towards credit hour requirements for Latin Honors at graduation. Grades of “S” are not assigned grade point values and are not used in the computation of the grade point average.

Scholarships: The credit hours from “S” (Satisfactory) graded courses will be permitted to count towards credit hour requirements for a university scholarship. Grades of “S” are not assigned grade point values and are not used in the computation of the grade point average.
